## Your Safety Is Our Top Priority

The PMCC Board, Covid Committee and League Representatives have always been and will continue to be focused on a safe curling environment for all our members.

The Omicron variant is proving to be more transmissible and therefore we need to be more diligent in ensuring that we adhere to our protocols. Of course, as we know these protocols are subject to change depending on the PHO orders. We will continue to adjust our protocols as the restrictions change.

We ask that everyone be patient, be considerate and be respectful of your fellow curlers and facility staff.

Many have expressed safety concerns and would appreciate you adhering to our safety guidelines. Thank you in advance for your compliance and we're looking forward to seeing everyone back on the ice!

#### **BC's Proof of Vaccination**

- All PMCC members need to be double vaccinated.
- Proof of at least two COVID-19 vaccinations is mandatory.

#### **How To Prepare for The Vaccine Verification**

- Any new PMCC members who have not been verified for their two vaccinations will need to do so before accessing our ice.
- The process involves scanning your vaccination QR code, verifying your identification with a piece of government issued photo identification, and the signing of a waiver.
- The waiver allows PMCC to keep your signature on file which indicates that you have met the vaccination requirement. This allows you to curl on PMCC ice without being verified every time you curl

### In The Recreation Facility

- Masks are <u>mandatory</u> upon entry to the recreation facility and are required to be worn in the facility, at all times, unless you are on the curling rink ice.
- Masks <u>will not</u> be supplied by the city. All members must provide their own masks.
- Hand sanitizer is readily available at the front entrance of the facility for all users.

#### On The Ice

- Masks are optional when engaged in physical activity on the ice. If you choose to wear a mask, surgical masks are recommended as they make it easier to breathe during physical activity.
- Please maintain 6 feet of social distancing on the ice.
- Sanitizing wipes will be available to clean rock handles (each team is responsible
  to clean their own rocks at the start of their game). Please remember to sanitize
  or wash your hands after your game.
- Curling will be played by the regular rules and format.

#### In The Lounge/ Bar Area- closed until further notice due to PHO Orders

- Masks are **required** unless you are eating/drinking
- There will be no jumping from table to table to socialize.
- Staff will be required to wear masks in this space.
- Maximum of 6 people per table.
- Maximum capacity is 75 occupants.
- Hand sanitizer will be readily available.

These requirements are subject to change without notice.

\*\*\*League representatives book the lounge times for your events and league social time during league play. It is each members responsibility to adhere to these scheduled times. Please be respectful of our bar and city staff. \*\*\*
